029/16 RENISHAW & SPINKHILL COMMUNITY HALL (R&SCH)

A report from the R&SCH was received. The facility has some new Committee Members and there is an increase in attendance figures. With the support from the Parish Council and adjustments to the hire charges the future of the facility is looking positive. RESOLVED any repairs or maintenance requests to be placed on the next agenda.

030/16 MARSH LANE COMMUNITY HALL (MLCH)

A report from the MLCH was received. They have a newly formed Management Committee who are exploring ways of promoting the venue. They are reviewing their administration procedures and policies. There are few slates missing off the roof which need replacing as a matter of urgency. The main fabric of the building is looking tired and there are a few repairs required. RESOLVED emergency repairs within the budget to be carried out. Other maintenance and repairs to be scheduled. Costs outside budget are to be approved by Full Council.

to hold the scheduled 4 August Community Hall & Premises meeting at their hall. Their Memorandum of Understanding to be agreed and signed at this meeting.

031/16 GOLDEN BALL CHANGING ROOMS

The hire charge for the Golden Ball changing facilities is £135 per season. There is one team who currently use these facilities. The Council received £30 from the coin fed water heater. The water bill for the changing rooms last year was £863 and the electric bill was £193 RESOLVED Committee to monitor the water heater settings/charges.

The District Council receive the income from the hire of the pitch and they decide how many matches are played per season RESOLVED Clerk to find out how many teams are using the pitch and to ask if they can accept any more teams.
