These events will include:

February Half Term – Two Pizza workshop parties one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Eckington Civic Centre and Renishaw. £1,000

Easter Holiday – Easter Egg Hunt and Crafts with lunch 2 days. Eckington Civic Centre and Renishaw. £1,500.

Summer events x 5 - 3 sessions at Renishaw and 2 sessions at Eckington. Possible visit the Renishaw Hall £5,000

(2 events indoor at Eckington Civic Centre) and (3 events outside at Renishaw sports field with option to go indoors if it's raining)

- Professionally organised indoor and outdoor sports and games (Samba Sports) – learning new skills, keeping fit and team building. Improve children's health and wellbeing.
- Craft Activities - learning new skills and building on own skills. Opportunity to be creative and improve health and wellbeing.
- Children's Entertainer
- Bouncy castle - Plenty of exercise and a good way to let of steam.
- Hot meal provided at Eckington venue
- Packed lunch provided at Renishaw venue

October Half Term – Hot meal, crafts and Halloween disco/games. Civic Centre £1,000

Christmas

Eckington Civic Centre - Show with food and a visit from Santa £1,000

Marsh Lane - Christmas party, with food and a visit from Santa £500

Renishaw - Theatre show, disco, food and a visit from Santa £750

Total £10,750
