**Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 – Claim for a Right of Way
Claim to add a bridleway from Pitt Street to Setcup Lane - Parish of Eckington**

The County Council has received an application to amend the Definitive Map and Statement under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and you have been identified as a possible landowner/occupier affected by the claim.

All local authorities are required to keep and update the Definitive Map and Statement for their county. Under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 individuals and groups can submit evidence to make changes to the map and statement which the County Council has a duty to investigate.

Derbyshire County Council are currently in receipt of a substantial number of claims of this nature which are largely dealt with in chronological order of receipt. Following acknowledgement of the claim and various initial procedures the application awaits its turn in the system. When the file reaches its turn in the queue you will then be contacted as part of a consultation exercise and given the opportunity to provide your comments and views on this matter.

During the course of the investigation of this claim it may be necessary for officers of the County Council to conduct several site visits to inspect the right of way and therefore they may need access on to your land. Your co-operation with this would be greatly appreciated, however if you have any objections to this please inform the County Council in writing.

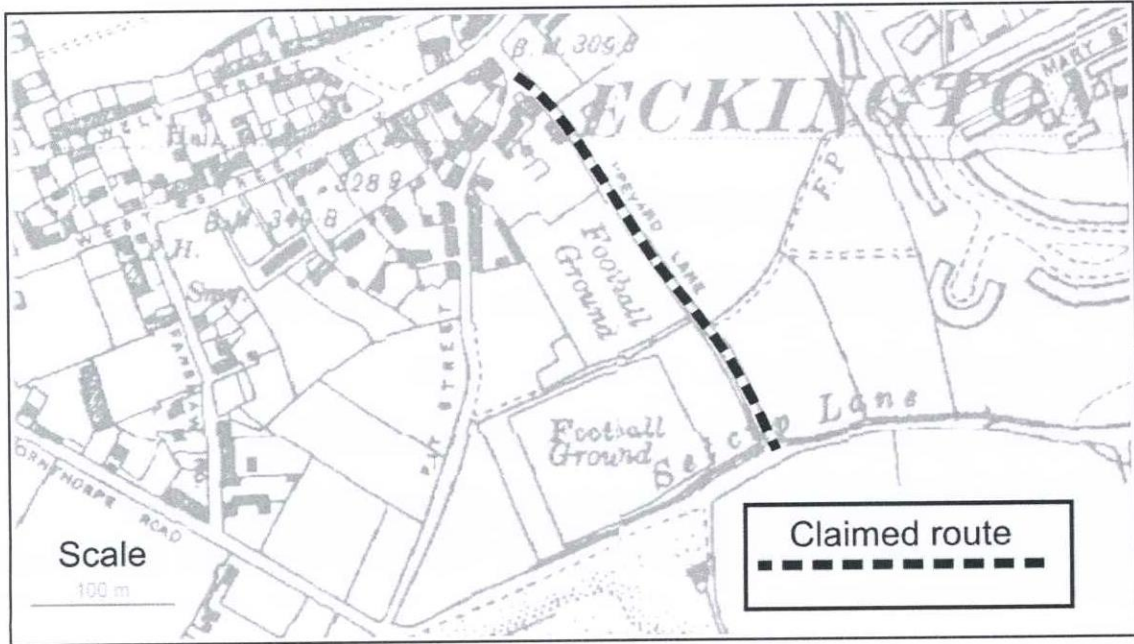
