

Community Speed Watch Report

A third Community Speed Watch was carried out on the 12th April on the B6056 near the Butchers Arms at Marsh Lane. Unfortunately, 10 of the 12 recorded were rejected (8 came back as no trace, 1 was below the speed threshold and the other was a PNC issue). None of the letters posted went to a local address.

Two further Community Speed Watch locations have been approved and watches are scheduled for the following dates:

1st June 10am on the B6056 Marsh Lane, down the main road past the fox and hounds towards Eckington, to check the speed of the cars coming up from the petrol station to the first speed camera.

8th June 10am on the A6135 Eckington near the Aldi supermarket.

Councillor Kathy Clegg has completed the theory training for the Community Speed Watch and will receive in house practical training on site at one of the scheduled Community Speed Watches.
