Solar Panels

The grant proposal put forward to Veolia for £16,069.00 was successful.

The Parish Council need to put £1,785.00 to the grant received to cover the balance of £17,854.00. The Deputy Clerk is aiming to get the solar panels up by Christmas, depending on the availability of the company who are fitting them.

Community Events
