26/21 Environmental Policy

27/21 Action Log

Members discuss the action plan and the ongoing tasks. RECOMMEND

- £100 to purchase wild flower seeds for the uncut grass in the old section Cemetery and ask Dronfield Council how they maintain their wild flower sections.
- Obtaining quotations for a blade hand dryer for the men's toilet in the Civic Centre.
- Obtain quotation from Anderson tree care to remove every other tree in the Beech hedge at the Cemetery.
- Ask Anderson tree care for advise on tree planting in the Cemetery.
- Looking at other recycling options for the Civic Centre.
- Looking at Electric Vehicles for when the current Parsi Council Van is no longer usable.
- To potentially have 30 trees planted around the uncut edges of the Marsh Lane playing field to create an orchard. Councillor Kenyon to provide updates.
