A hate crime is an incident that was motivated by prejudice or hate, perceived to be based on disability, race, religion or belief, age, sexual orientation, transgender identity or membership of an alternative subculture.

A hate crime can be any sort of crime and can be committed against a person or against property. It can be a physical assault or verbal abuse, face to face or online. It can also be criminal damage or vandalism, like graffiti or other damage to your house or car, or a place of worship.
